Tuition Refund Policy

If a student leaves within 1-2 weeks from the start of the term, the parent is entitled to 75% refund.

If a student leaves within 3-4 weeks from the start of the term, the parent is entitled to 50 % refund.

If a student leaves after 4 weeks from the start of the term, the parent is not entitled to a refund.

Registration, Capital Development Fund Fee, testing and special fees are non refundable and non transferable.



Please be reminded that cell phones are not allowed in school. Phones confiscated from students will have to be collected by parents from the office



You are reminded to collect AFTER SCHOOL students no later than 3:15 p.m. Clubs are dismissed at 3: 45 p.m. Students should not be on campus after 4:00 p.m. as the security guard leaves at 3:30 p.m. and the office staff leaves at 4:00 p.m.

Protocols

The following health protocols remain unchanged:

Children with the following symptoms must stay home:

Headache Sore throat

Body aches or chills Cough

Vomiting Diarrhea

Sinus congestion Runny nose

Red and inflamed eyes **Fever**

(Excessive sneezing)

Medications that require administering during school, must be prescribed by a physician and have a pharmacy label on the bottle with the child's name and dosage.

If the medications are to suppress a cough or a fever, your child should remain home. Medications must not be sent to school in a child's bag. These must be handed into the office by an adult.

The following protocols have changed:

Wearing a mask in school is now optional. The school will support those who wish to continue to wear their masks.

Your child must continue to carry a mask in his or her bag in the event he or she becomes sick throughout the day.

We ask parents to remind their children of the correct way to stifle a sneeze or a cough.

We will do the same at school.



DROP & PICK UP

We will use the three options every day until further notice. Teachers will park on the basketball court.

OPTION 1
3rd Street
Drive Up

- 1. Drive up to the stage.
- 2. Make a U-turn.
- 3. Let the children off by the office entrance.

OPTION 2 4th Street Drive Through

- Enter through the northern gate. (Coconut Grove Ave.)
- 2. Stay to the right. Drive up to the white picket fence.
- 3. Let the child/children off as quickly as possible.
- 4. Leave through the Southern gate. (Palm Tree Ave.) GATE LOCKED AT 3:30 P.M.

OPTION 3

- 1. Park in the church yard.
- 2. Use rectory side entrance
- 3. Walk your child through the side gate.
