School Policy and Reminders

The school year can be compared to a race. You start strong and finish strong. We started out respecting school rules and procedures. Most of us continue to do so. However there are a number of rules that are being blatantly disregarded:

Uniform: Students are to wear their complete uniform each day. This includes the specified black shoes (not tennis shoes), neck ties, Peter Pan collars for the girls, NO hair extensions . . .

Tuition Refund: If a student leaves within 1 – 2 weeks to the start of the term, the parent is entitled to 75% refund. If a student leaves with 3 – 4 weeks to the start of the term, the parent is entitled to 50% refund; If a student leaves after 4 weeks to the start of the term, the parent is not entitled to a refund. Registration, testing and special fees are non-refundable.
