Majority Rule Holiday: Thursday, January 10, 2019

STUDENT COLLECTION: School is dismissed at 3:00 p.m. on a regular school day. Students must be collected NO LATER THAN 3:15 p.m. if they are not participating in extracurricular clubs or classes. Those participating in extracurricular clubs and classes must be collected no later than 4:00 p.m. on a regular school day. On early dismissal days, students are to be collected no later than 30 minutes after dismissal.

School Fee Schedule:

2018 - 2019 school year

2nd payment due in office **December 3, 2018** 3rd payment due on or before **March 1, 2019**

Tuition Refund: If a student leaves within 1-2 weeks to the start of the term, the parent is entitled to a 75% refund. If a student leaves between the 3^{rd} and 4^{th} week at the beginning of the term, the parent is entitled to a 50% refund; Any student leaving after 4 weeks at the beginning of the term the parent will not be entitled to a refund. Registration, testing and special fees are non-refundable.
