Character Trait: Obedience

Eerdman's Bible Dictionary states, "True 'hearing,' or obedience, involves the physical hearing that inspires the hearer, and a belief or trust that in turn motivates the hearer to act in accordance with the speaker's desires. "In Jesus Christ we find the perfect model of obedience. Those who say they live in God should live their lives as Jesus did. (1 John 2:3-6, NLT)

The disobedience of Adam brought sin and death into the world. This is the basis of the term "original sin." But Christ's perfect obedience restores fellowship with God for everyone who believes in him:

Mary was the mother of the Messiah, Jesus Christ, the Savior of the world. She was a willing servant, trusting in God and obeying his call.

We don't learn obedience overnight; it's a lifelong process that we pursue by making it a daily goal.

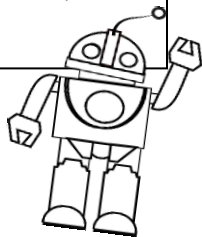
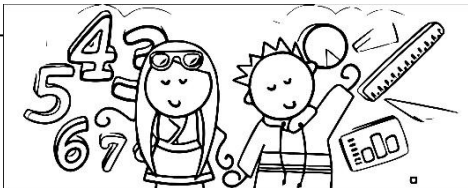
Archdiocesan Sports is May 17, 2019. Come out and support our team at the T.A. Robinson Stadium.

School Fee Schedule:

2019 – 2020 school year

1st Payment 2019 – 2020 school year is **June 3, 2019**

Tuition Refund: If a student leaves within 1 – 2 weeks from the start of the term, the parent is entitled to 75% refund. If a student leaves with 3 – 4 weeks from the start of the term, the parent is entitled to 50% refund; if a student leaves after 4 weeks from the start of the term, the parent is not entitled to a refund. Registration, testing and special fees are non-refundable.
