136 Years Catholic Education

In 1889, five Sisters of Charity from Mt. St. Vincent's in New York came to Nassau and founded the first Catholic school in The Bahamas. There names were Sister Dolores Van Rensselea, as superior, Teresa Alacoque Nagle, Casilda Saunders, Mercedes Donovan and Maria Corsini Gallagher. Accompanying them were Mother Ambrosia, and Sisters Irene Gonzaga Batell, Maria Dodge and three other women, who came to assist the Sisters. After a 5 day voyage, they arrived in Nassau on October 28, 1889, sailing aboard the SS Santiago.

On November 4, 1889, St. Francis Xavier School, the first Catholic school in The Bahamas, a free school, opened its doors on West Street. The vision of the Sisters of Charity was to equip the Bahamian populace with the skills, attitudes and behaviours that would help to further develop the people and shape their destiny.

Today, the Catholic School system is the largest private school system in The Bahamas, serving approximately 3,000 students and boasting an alumni community of tens of thousands. At present, there are a total of nine Catholic schools on New Providence, Grand Bahama and Abaco. The family of Catholic schools in The Bahamas include Aquinas College; St. Cecilia's School; Sts. Francis & Joseph School; St. Thomas More School; Xavier's Lower School; Mary, Star of the Sea Catholic Academy (Grand Bahama); St. Francis de Sales School (Abaco); Every Child Counts (Abaco); and St. Augustine's College.


